RACE REPORT David Tavares



<u>Aug. 2-4: Road America @ Elkhart Lake, Wis.:</u> AWA and Pratt Miller teams raced in the IMSA series, GTD PRO class. The No. 3 Pratt Miller Vette ran with drivers Antonio Garcia and Alexander Sims. The No. 4 Vette ran with drivers Tommy Milner and Nicky Catsburg.

The first unlucky break was when the 2nd place No. 3 Vette, with Alex Sims driving, was struck by another GTD Pro car and spun out onto the gravel. The recovery crew quickly pulled Sims back onto the track to continue the race. The 2-hour, 40-minute race was plagued with 6 full-course caution periods. Two yellow flags in the final hour worked against the Corvettes as they were planning on a good fuel strategy to give them an edge at the end. But the caution periods gave all the teams a chance to refuel. The No. 3 Vette finished 5th in the GTD PRO class with the No. 4 Vette right behind them.

The AWA race team ran the No.13 Z06 in the GTD class with Matt Bell & Oray Fidani. Bell and Fidani gained 16 positions overall and 10 in their class. The No. 13 Corvette matched the Pratt Miller results for their best GTD finish of the season.

GTD Pro Race Results: 1st: Ferrari, 2nd: BMW, 3rd: Aston Martin, 5th: #3 Vette, 6th: #4 Vette. There were 10 cars in the class.

GTD Race Results: 1st: BMW, 2nd: Ferrari, 3rd: Acura, 5th: #13 Vette. There were 15 cars in this class.

Aug 16-18: Road America @ Elkhart Lake, Wis.: DXDT Racing competed in the Fanatec GT World Challenge America series. The No. 63 car raced in Pro Class with drivers Tommy Milner & Alec Udell. The No. 8 car raced in Pro-Am class with drivers Bryan Sellers and Bryson Morris. Milner started in the class pole position and drove for the 1st 40 minutes, handing the car over to Udell. Udell moved up to the lead position on the 1st turn and stayed there.

Meanwhile, Morris in the No. 8 car moved up to 2nd place overall and 1st place in the class. The two Corvettes completed the final race of the weekend with a 1st & 2nd place overall finish!!

Race Results: 1st Race, Pro class: 1st: #63 Vette, 2nd: Acura, 3rd: Porsche. There were 5 cars in the class.

Race Results: 1st Race, Pro-Am class: 1st: BMW, 2nd: Porsche, 3rd: Porsche, 8th: #8 Vette. There were 8 cars in the class.

Race Results: 2nd Race, Pro class: 1st: #63 Vette, 2nd: Porsche, 3rd: Acura. There were 5 cars in the class.

Race Results: 2nd Race, Pro-Am class: 1st: #8 Vette, 2nd: BMW, 3rd: Mercedes. There were 8 cars in the class.

The first-year Z06 GT3.R has had 8 race victories since its debut in January and this was the 2nd 1-2 finish!

<u>7/14 – Six Hours of Sa Paulo (Brazil):</u> TF Sport raced in the WEC series in the LMGT3 class. Tom Van Rompuy, Rui Andrade and Charlie Eastwood raced the #81 Z06 racecar. Hiroshi Koizumi, Sebastien Baud and Daniel Juncadella raced in the #82 Z06 race car.

Von Rompuy started in the 8th spot in the #81 Vette and moved up two places in the first ten minutes. Then the Vette was struck by one of the GT3-class Porsches and spun off the track. He came back in 14th place and made his way to 8th place by the end of the race.

Koizumi in the #82 Vette moved up to 9th place from his 13th place starting position. When Baud took over, the car had to serve a drive through penalty. Soon after that, the car had a mechanical problem which sidelined the car for the rest of the race.

Race Results: 1st: Porsche, 2nd: Aston Martin, 3rd: McLaren, 8th: #81 Vette. The #82 Vette did not finish. There were 18 cars in the class.

7/19-7/21 – Virginia International Raceway: DXDT Racing ran 2 cars in the Fanatec GT World Challenge America series. The DXDT team spent 2 days of testing & practicing before the race. The #63 car raced in Pro Class with drivers Tommy Milner & Alec Udell. The #8 car raced in Pro-Am class with Bryan Sellers & Scott Smithson.

In the 1st race, the DXDT team executed perfect pit strategy resulting in another 1st place finish in class and overall, for the Z06 GT3.R Corvette!

In the 2nd race on Sunday, the #63 Vette had another 1st place in class & 2nd place overall.

Meanwhile, the #8 car racing in the Pro-Am class had a 6th place finish in their 1st race on Saturday. This team also managed a 3rd place podium finish on Sunday!

The new Z06 managed to get 5 podium finishes in July! Wow!!

<u>8/30–9/1 - Lone Star Le Mans (Austin):</u> This will be the next race for TF Sport race team in the WEC series.

At a Ceremony on Saturday, August 31, 2024, the Corvette Hall of Fame Inducted its Class of 2024

Corvette Racing Drivers Oliver Gavin and Jan Magnussen

Oliver Gavin and Jan Magnussen became two of Corvette Racing's brightest stars during a decorated run together in the 2000's and 2010. Gavin joined the team full time in the No 4 Corvette in 2003 and the following year Magnussen became a co-driver with Olivier Beretta at at the Le Mans, Sebring & Road Atlanta. The trio won Le Mans every year from 2004 to 2006, as well as Sebring once and Road Atlanta. For the 2007 season, Magnussen entrusted to drive full-time in the No. 3 Corvette. Together Gavin and Magnussen have won a Championships driving for Corvette Racing with 51 wins by Gavin and 34 by Magnussen.

Corvette Chief Engineer

Tad Juechter was on the design team for the C7 and made a special point to redesign the interior of the Corvette. The mid-engine C8 is the first Corvette Juechter got to create from the ground up. Under his leadership the reputation of the Corvette as one of the worlds finest sports cars continue to grow.




After lunch, there was a jam session with Dave & Gary on guitars, Bob on harmonica and Jennifer on violin.
