### RACE REPORT

**David Tavares** 



**7/12-7/14 - Canadian Tire Motorsport Park:** AWA & Pratt Miller race teams ran this race in the IMSA series. Pratt Miller raced in GTD-PRO class and the AWA team ran in the GTD class. The #3 Pratt Miller Vette ran with drivers Antonio Garcia and Alexander Sims. The #4 Pratt Miller Vette ran with drivers Tommy Milner & Nicky Catsburg.

The #3 car started in the pole position and led for 109 of 113 laps. Garcia had a 5-7 second lead until a full course yellow flag dropped with 16 minutes to go! This caused many of the GTD cars to be ahead of them at the restart. Garcia managed to thread his way through the GTD cars and kept his position.

Meanwhile, Milner and Catsburg in the #4 car weren't far behind. Corvette Racing & Pratt Miller have been getting closer to a #1 finish this year and they finally did it. The new Z06 GT3.R finally reached 1<sup>st</sup> place! The #3 car crossed the finish line with the #4 car not far behind. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes for Pratt Miller & Corvette Racing!

Meanwhile, the AWA race team ran the #13 Z06 race car in the GTD class. Orey Fidani climbed to 2<sup>nd</sup> place from his start in 11<sup>th</sup> place. Unfortunately, he was pushed off the track and into the barriers. Fidani climbed out, was evaluated and released. His team attempted to get the race car back on the track, but the damage was too great.

**GTD Pro Race Results:** 1st: #3 Vette, 2nd: #4 Vette, 3rd: Porsche. There were 9 cars in the class.

**GTD Race Results:** 1st: Aston Martin, 2nd: Mercedes, 3rd: McLaren. The #13 car did not finish. There were 9 cars in the class

<u>7/14 – Six Hours of Sa Paulo (Brazil):</u> TF Sport raced in the WEC series in the LMGT3 class. Tom Van Rompuy, Rui Andrade and Charlie Eastwood raced the #81 Z06 racecar. Hiroshi Koizumi, Sebastien Baud and Daniel Juncadella raced in the #82 Z06 race car.

Von Rompuy started in the 8<sup>th</sup> spot in the #81 Vette and moved up two places in the first ten minutes. Then the Vette was struck by one of the GT3-class Porsches and spun off the track. He came back in 14<sup>th</sup> place and made his way to 8<sup>th</sup> place by the end of the race.

Koizumi in the #82 Vette moved up to 9<sup>th</sup> place from his 13<sup>th</sup> place starting position. When Baud took over, the car had to serve a drive through penalty. Soon after that, the car had a mechanical problem which sidelined the car for the rest of the race.

**Race Results:** 1st: Porsche, 2nd: Aston Martin, 3rd: McLaren, 8th: #81 Vette. The #82 Vette did not finish. There were 18 cars in the class.

7/19-7/21 – Virginia International Raceway: DXDT Racing ran 2 cars in the Fanatec GT World Challenge America series. The DXDT team spent 2 days of testing & practicing before the race. The #63 car raced in Pro Class with drivers Tommy Milner & Alec Udell. The #8 car raced in Pro-Am class with Bryan Sellers & Scott Smithson.

In the 1st race, the DXDT team executed perfect pit strategy resulting in another 1st place finish in class and overall, for the Z06 GT3.R Corvette!

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> race on Sunday, the #63 Vette had another 1<sup>st</sup> place in class & 2<sup>nd</sup> place overall.

Meanwhile, the #8 car racing in the Pro-Am class had a 6<sup>th</sup> place finish in their 1<sup>st</sup> race on Saturday. This team also managed a 3<sup>rd</sup> place podium finish on Sunday!

### **Race Results:**

1st Race, Pro class: 1st: #63 Vette, 2nd: Porsche, 3rd: Porsche. There were 5 cars in the class.

1<sup>st</sup> Race, Pro-Am class: 1<sup>st</sup>: Porsche, 2<sup>nd</sup>: BMW, 3<sup>rd</sup>: Mercedes, 6<sup>th</sup>: #8 Vette. There were 8 cars in the class.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Race, Pro class:** 1<sup>st</sup>: #63 Vette, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Porsche, 3<sup>rd</sup>: Acura. There were 5 cars in the class.

**2**<sup>nd</sup> **Race, Pro-Am class:** 1<sup>st</sup>: Mercedes, 2<sup>nd</sup>: BMW, 3<sup>rd</sup>: #8 Vette. There were 7 cars in the class.

The new Z06 managed to get 5 podium finishes in July! Wow!!

<u>8/2-8/4 - Road America @ Elkhart Lake, Wis.:</u> This will be the next race for AWA & Pratt Miller racing in the IMSA series.

<u>8/16-8/18 – Road America @ Elkhart Lake, Wis.</u>: This will be the next race for DXDT Racing in the Fanatec GT World Challenge America series.

<u>8/30–9/1 - Lone Star Le Mans (Austin):</u> This will be the next race for TF Sport race team in the WEC series.




