

RACE REPORT

Oct.3-6: Eight hours of Indianapolis @ Indianapolis Motor Speedway:

This was the final race of the year for DXDT Racing in the Fanatec GT World Challenge America series. The #63 car raced in Pro Class with drivers Tommy Milner & Alec Udell, resulting in a 3th place podium finish.

The #64 car raced in Pro-Am class with Bryan Sellers, Patrick Liddy & Blake McDonald, finishing in 6th place.

Oct.9-12- Motul Petit Lemans @ Michelin Raceway:

This was the final race of the year for AWA Racing and Pratt Miller Motorsports racing in the IMSA series.

The No. 3 Pratt Miller Vette ran in GTD Pro class with drivers Antonio Garcia and Alexander Sims. The #3 Vette suffered brake issues requiring two extra pit stops. The race car also suffered right-rear chassis damage during the Thursday night practice session. The race crew worked through the night making repairs & welding. As a result of their efforts, the #3 car ended up with a 5th place finish. This finish was good enough for the race team to get 3rd place in the GTD PRO Drivers & Teams standing for the season.

The No. 4 Pratt Miller Vette ran in GTD Pro class with drivers Tommy Milner, Nicky Catsburg and Earl Bamber. The race car started in the 2nd place position. But the car was hit by an LMP2 car, damaging the front & rear suspension on the right side. The race car was 50 laps down when it entered back in the race and finished 12th in class.

The AWA race team ran their #13 Z06 in GTD class with Matt Bell, Lars Kern and Oray Fidani. The #13 car finished in 12 place in class and 4th place for the Akin award. This meant that drivers Fidani and Bell were the highest finishing pair for 3 races, securing automatic entry for next 24 hours of LeMans.

Chevrolet also ended the 1st season in GTD Pro with the IMSA Michelin Endurance Cup Manufacturers Championship.

<u>Nov.2: Eight Hours of Bahrain</u> – This was the final race of the year for TF Sport in the WEC series. The #81 Z06 ran in the LMGT3 class with Tom Van Rompuy, Rui Andrade & Charlie Eastwood, finishing in 2nd place in the class.

The #82 car of Hiroshi Koizumi, Sébastien Baud and Daniel Juncadella finished on the podium 3rd class position.

This was the first double-podium finish for the Corvette brand in the FIA World Endurance Championship series.

Race Results: LMGT3: 1st: Ferrari, 2nd: #81 Vette, 3rd: #82 Vette.
